Macro issues that are a backdrop to the event

- Canadian PM Justin Trudeau's government has actioned the development of a plan to transition netpen salmon farming in British Columbia by 2025. The goal is to increase the country's marine protected areas to cover 25 percent of Canada's oceans by 2025 and shift towards land-based aquaculture. The salmon farming industry's reaction to Trudeau's mandate has been widely negative.
- There has been multiple announcements indicating a potential substantial growth in land-based salmon production across North America in recent years. Trend of land-based salmon farming is beginning to gain interest, with production costs dropping and prices along with them.

In the context of increased production of land-based salmon farming and Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau's push to end net pen salmon farming for British Columbia farmers, the IntraFish Seafood Leadership Forum will highlight the burning issues and opportunities surrounding the sector.
